

## EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

The following equipment and facilities are available to participants on the scheme. If you have any specific queries regarding the facilities listed, please contact us for more information.

Booking arrangements and induction meetings will be necessary for most workshop areas.

**Library** - on site specialist art and design library with lending and reference facilities

**Lecture programme** - including visiting lecturers

**Printmaking** - lithography, plate and stone, etching, screen process, digital imaging, relief print, photo-process

**Wood construction** - frame and stretcher making, band, radial and circular saws, lathes, sanders and finishers, pillar drills, hand routers

**Ceramics** - wheels, pugmills, gas and electric kilns, extruders

**Metalworking** - some small-scale metalwork facilities may be available by arrangement

**Mould making** - plaster, ceramic shell.

**Digital technologies** - Mac and PC computers and scanners, Computer-aided design and modelling, animation, time-based media, sound, colour and black & white laser printers, laser cutting

**Film and Video** - camcorders, VHS editing and mixing, audio dubbing and computer overlay, digital video, frame advance animation

**Photography** – photography studios , black and white darkrooms, analogue and digital cameras and printing

**Other equipment / facilities** - e.g., paper making, bookbinding, spray booths
