EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

The following equipment and facilities are available to participants on the scheme. If you have any specific queries regarding the facilities listed, please contact us for more information. **You will need to have the required skills to use these facilities as techniques are not taught as part of the placement**

Library - on site specialist art and design library with lending and reference facilities

Lecture programme - including visiting lecturers

Print Hub - printmaking and textile screen print processors, relief printing, dry point, lino, mono, solar plate, and limited letter press

Wood construction - frame and stretcher making, lathes, sanders and finishers, pillar drills, CNC routing (CAD skills needed)

Metalworking - MIG and oxyacetylene welding, bandsaws, pipe bending, cutting, and folding

Ceramics - hand built only

Digital technologies - Mac and PC computers and scanners, Computer-aided design, laser cutting

Digital design Hub - Mimaki fabric printer, sublimation printer, laser cutter, Roland decal plotter /cutter, UV printer, large format photography printers (all require CAD skill in use this is not taught) book binding and mounting.

Film and Video - digital editing and mixing, audio dubbing and computer overlay, digital video, frame advance animation

Photography - black and white and colour studios and darkrooms rooms and mural processing

Textiles / Fashion - hand weaving, domestic knitting machines, sewing machines
